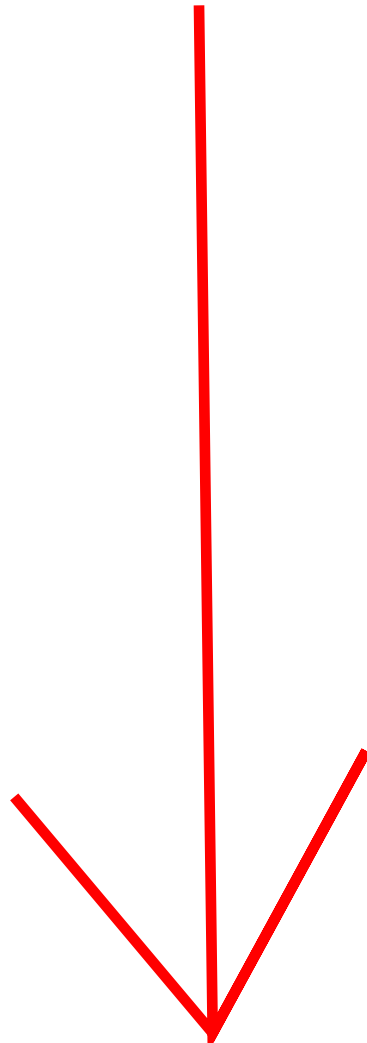

“Underground After Hours Tour”

Scandal and Intrigue Await!

Relive the night life of Gold Rush Sacramento – if you dare!

Your guides for “Underground After Hours” divulge matters they just can’t discuss on the daytime tours: Murder, mischief, madness, mayhem – and madams!

Spend a night on the new town with a shady character from the past, who’ll show you around to the saloons, gaming halls, theaters and houses of ill-fame – places you can only see in the twilight. Meet swindlers, soiled doves and sneaky speculators! Hear all the gossip on murders of passion, political intrigue, and the century’s most notorious woman! Try your hand at a game of chance!

“Underground After Hours” tours depart from the Sacramento History Museum, 101 I Street in Old Sacramento. This half-mile guided historical walking tour lasts about 90 minutes and visits areas with uneven surfaces and low ceilings. The tour is ADA compliant and can accommodate **up to 20 people**. This will be a private tour reserved for the AADMRT conference attendees and costs only \$20!

Please arrive 10 to 15 minutes early because this tour departs from the museum precisely on time at 6pm sharp! The museum is approximately half a mile from the hotel.

Tours run rain or shine – please dress for the weather, and wear comfortable and closed-toed shoes.

The tour ends in front of Fat City Bar & Café, at J and Front streets, with a commemorative shot glass and a ticket for a discount drink.

The comedians (assisted with some alcohol) will immediately be a great way to unwind from an intense day of valuable educational and informative presentations.

The AADMRT conference will end at on Saturday at 3pm. After sitting in a chair for two days absorbing all that valuable information from the awesome speakers, now it's time for physical activity!

After the meeting, it would be a perfect time to explore the beautiful area around the hotel. Another option is that Merry Hampton and Eric Iwamoto are working on a small group activity for the afternoon.



Around 6pm, everyone should be ready to feast on dinner! We picked Oz Korean BBQ's all you can eat for \$22.99! The location is about twenty minutes drive from the hotel. The restaurant requires every person in the party to order all you can eat. Appetizers include: pot stickers, Cajun garlic fries, French fries and sweet chili wings. BBQ items include: Marinated prime bone (and boneless) beef short ribs, sesame marinated boneless prime rib, thinly sliced rib-eye, sweet pork, BBQ chicken, garlic chicken, mussels garlic shrimp plus more! Yes, they have vegetables too! If you have never dined at a Korean BBQ restaurant, now is the time! Note that each table has a built-in grill which allows everyone at the table to cook the meat exactly to each of your own personal preference. It's fun! We will stay at the restaurant no longer than two hours. Why? Because the night is still young!



After filling your tummies with BBQ, we are going to K1 Go Karts! These go-karts are all electric, meaning they have 100% torque the second you press the accelerator pedal! That also means no smelly exhaust fumes! The smooth track allows for some fun drifting in the corners. However, you will soon learn that drifting is not the quickest way around the track. Let's see who is the fastest! Guy? Gal? Who knows? The cost of two races, including a rental helmet, plus annual license (required) is \$49 and that includes a t-shirt! If you have your own helmet, bring it

We will eventually find our way back to the hotel for a night cap at the bar or perhaps you may have sufficient energy to go to Dive Bar (5 minute Uber ride from the Hotel) that has an aquarium over the bar.
